Sardardham Bhavan at Vaishnodevi circle in Ahmedabad has been developed by Patidar Samaj. Union Ministers Mansukh Mandaviya, Parshotam Rupala, Anupriya Patel, Gujarat Chief Minister Vijay Rupani, Deputy Chief Minister Nitin Patel and MPs and MLAs from Patidar Samaj in Gujarat remained present at the venue on this occasion.

3. Civil Aviation Minister Jyotiraditya Scindia, Telangana IT Minister K Taraka Ramarao to launch 'Medicine from the Sky' project

Union Civil Aviation Minister Jyotiraditya Scindia and Telangana IT Minister K Taraka Ramarao will be formally launching the 'Medicine from the Sky' project at Vikarabad in Telangana today. The project is a first of its kind in India as it is the first organized drone service in the health care sector for delivering medicines and Covid vaccines. A two-day trial of drones under the project held smoothly. 'Medicine from the Sky' is an initiative of the state Government led by the Emerging Technologies Wing of the IT Department in partnership with the World Economic Forum, NITI Aayog and Healthnet Global (Apollo Hospitals).

4. India to host inaugural India-Australia 22 Ministerial Dialogue

India will host the inaugural India-Australia 22 Ministerial Dialogue today. From the Indian side, Defence Minister Rajnath Singh and External Affairs Minister Dr. S. Jaishankar will lead the delegation which will comprise of officials from the Ministries of Defence and External Affairs. Australian Foreign Minister Marise Payne and Defence Minister Peter Dutton will lead the
