1. Bhupendra Patel to be sworn-in as new Chief Minister of Gujarat today

Ghatlodia BJP MLA Bhupendra Patel will be sworn-in as new Chief Minister of Gujarat today. State governor Acharya Devvrat will administer him the oath of office and secrecy at Raj Bhavan in Gandhinagar.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has inaugurated the state of art Sardardham Bhavan through video conferencing at Ahmedabad in Gujarat today. Prime Minister Modi has also laid the foundation stone of Sardardham Phase-II Kanya Chhatralay on this occasion.

3. 'Medicines from the Sky' project launched to send medicines to Primary Health Care Centres using drones

Union Minister for Civil Aviation Jyotiraditya Scindia has launched the Medicines from the Sky project to send medicines to Primary Health Care Centres using drones. The project was launched at Vikarabad in Telangana. Drones carry a payload of vaccines and other medicines to Public Health Centers under the project. The first sortie was carried out by a drone built by SkyAir Mobility for its Consortium partner Blue Dart Express and delivered a five-kg box of vaccines to a community Health Care Center located 3 kms away.

4. British teenager Emma Raducanu clinches Women's Singles title; Joe Salisbury of Britain and his American partner Desirae Krawczyk win Mixed Doubles title

Rising British sensation Emma Raducanu beat Leylah Fernandez of Canada to win Women's Singles title at US Open Tennis. The 18-year-old Emma Raducanu defeated her Canadian opponent in straight sets 6-4, 6-3 in the summit clash held at the Arthur Ashe Stadium in New York last night. She has become the first British woman to win the title in 53 years. Raducanu has also become the first British woman in 44 years to win a Grand Slam singles title.

Britain's Queen Elizabeth congratulated Raducanu on her success and said it is a testament to her

hard work and dedication.
UK Prime Minister Boris Johnson said Raducanu showed extraordinary skill in the game.

5. US Open : Daniil Medvedev stuns Novak Djokovic to win Maiden Grand Slam title

Daniil Medvedev of Russia lifted his first Grand Slam trophy after beating Novak Djokovic 6-4, 6-4, 6-4 in the US Open men's singles final at the Arthur Ashe Stadium in New York last night. The second seed Medvedev ended Djokovic's bid for a calendar slam and a 21st major by dominating from start to finish.

While Djokovic failed to become the third man after Don Budge and Rod Laver to sweep all four majors in the same year, Medvedev capped off a stellar US Open outing with a memorable win. Medvedev broke in the first game of the contest and from there, he remained in control throughout.
